

# 2026 MOSCOW RENAISSANCE FAIR POSTER CONTEST ENTRY FORM



- Deliver poster to **Tye Dye Everything** (527 S. Main #1, Moscow, ID) any day or time before **5:30 p.m. on Friday, March 6, 2026**.
- Public voting will be on **Saturday, March 7, 9:00 a.m. – 1:30 p.m., at the 1912 Center** (412 E 3<sup>rd</sup> Street, Moscow, ID) during the Winter Market.
- Moscow Renaissance Fair will choose the winner from the three design finalists receiving the most votes.
- The winner will receive a prize of \$200 and their artwork will appear on the advertising poster and program cover for the fair.

1. Artists must submit a printed entry, either freehand or computer-generated.
  - Make your print 11" x 17". This will be the actual size of the poster.
  - The winning artist will be required to submit a high-resolution **CMYK** PDF or EPS file of the final artwork on a thumb drive for printing and production.
2. Artwork must reflect the Moscow Renaissance Fair theme of "A Celebration of Spring." **We are not a time-period faire.** For questions about the theme, email [mrf\\_pr@moscowrenfair.org](mailto:mrf_pr@moscowrenfair.org).
3. The words "**53<sup>rd</sup> Annual Moscow Renaissance Fair**", "**May 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026**" and "**East City Park**" must appear prominently on the artwork.
4. The following text must be included and be legible: "**Featuring children's events, great food, a parade, costume contests, and the finest craftspeople and musicians**" and "**Free Admission.**"
5. The following words must appear in smaller but legible lettering along any edge of the artwork: [www.moscowrenfair.org](http://www.moscowrenfair.org)
6. Do not sign your artwork. The winning artist will have an opportunity to sign the posters after printing.
7. This contest is held in good faith and every attempt is made at keeping it a fair contest. Entries may not be promoted publicly (including social media or mass email) prior to the contest. The Moscow Renaissance Fair reserves the right to disqualify any entry that violates this rule.
8. Artists are responsible for retrieving their artwork after the contest. [see checkboxes below]
9. Artists of non-winning entries are encouraged to re-submit their work next year.
